Where are we now?

Well supported, with intention, by the St. Mark's community

The St. Mark's community appreciates SSC's presence on campus.

Building a "scaffolding" around the SSC members, and would like to grow this idea

There is a core group of 12-36 people that like to support SSC – Habitat for Humanity, a good board of 8 people

The SSC ministry has helped to make St. Mark's more visible to outside groups

The ministry involves hands-on service

SSC is in its 4th year of the program

Where do you want to go? Your vision for the future?

Would like more connections with the cathedral, and realize that this goes both ways

Would like more partners and a greater variety of partners, which could foster work done at St. Mark's. Examples would be in the areas of homelessness, immigration rights, LGBTQ organizations, recovery programs, housing.

Would like to have more "friends" (supporters)

What commitments are necessary to reach goals?

More board development, both in number and involvement

Possibly increase number of SSC members from 6 to 7

Increase physical space, with deck improvement and other ways
